Provide a vehicle for timely dissemination of accurate and updated hazardous material response information.

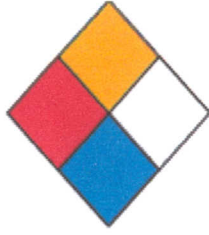
